

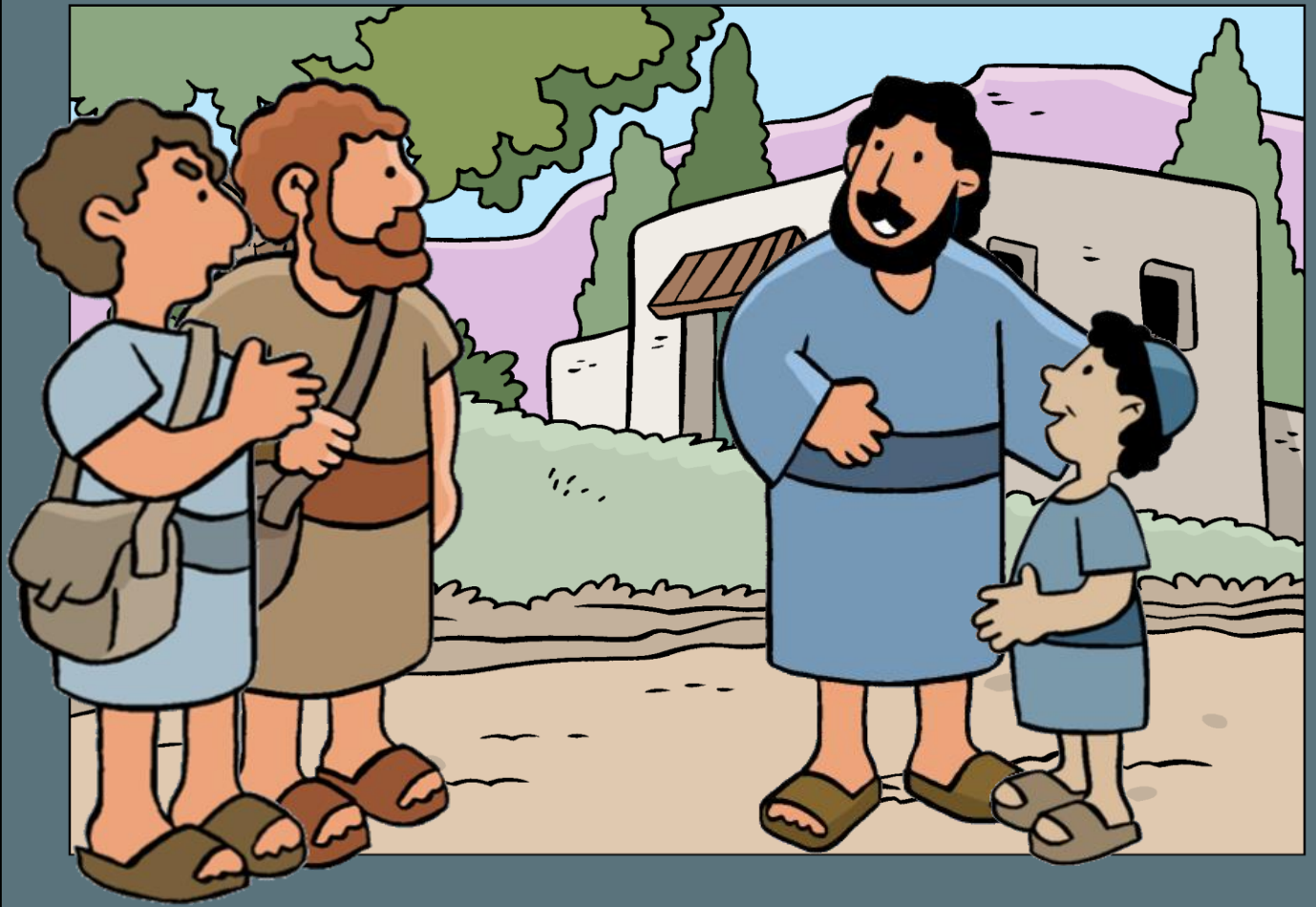


The Greatest in the Kingdom
