

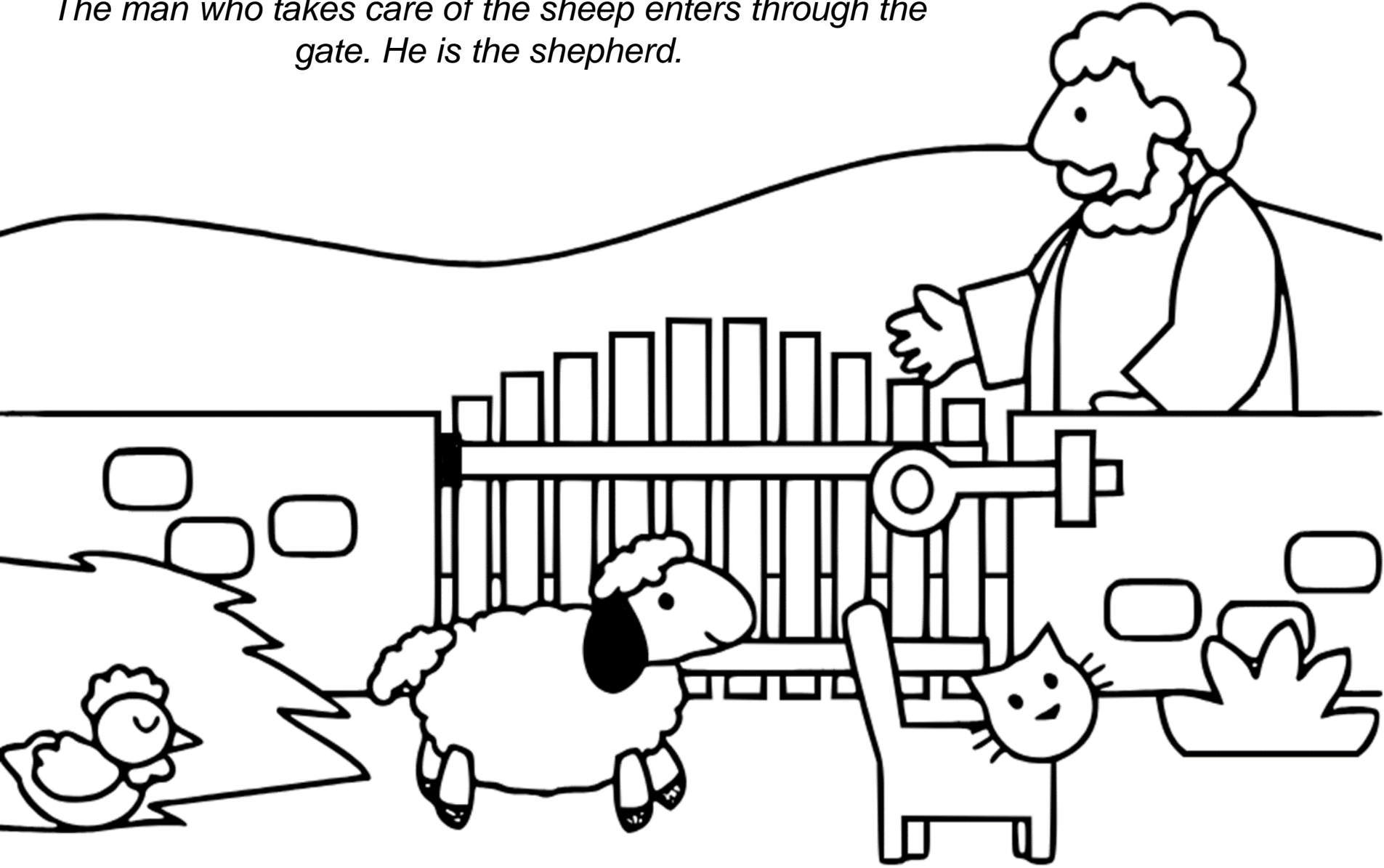
يَسُوعُ هُوَ الرَّاعِي الصَّالِحُ

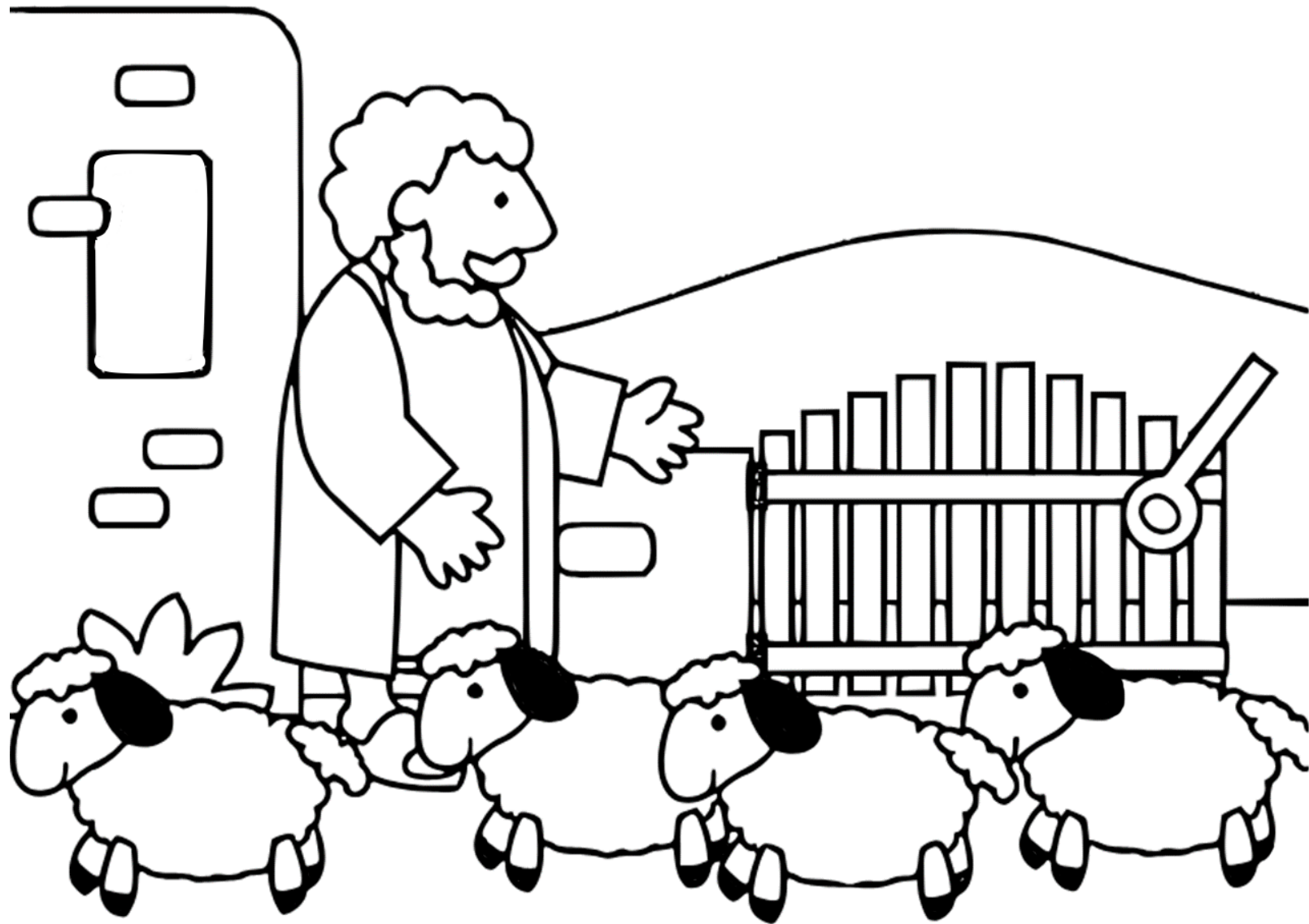
Jesus, the Good Shepherd

The man who takes care of the sheep enters through the gate. He is the shepherd.





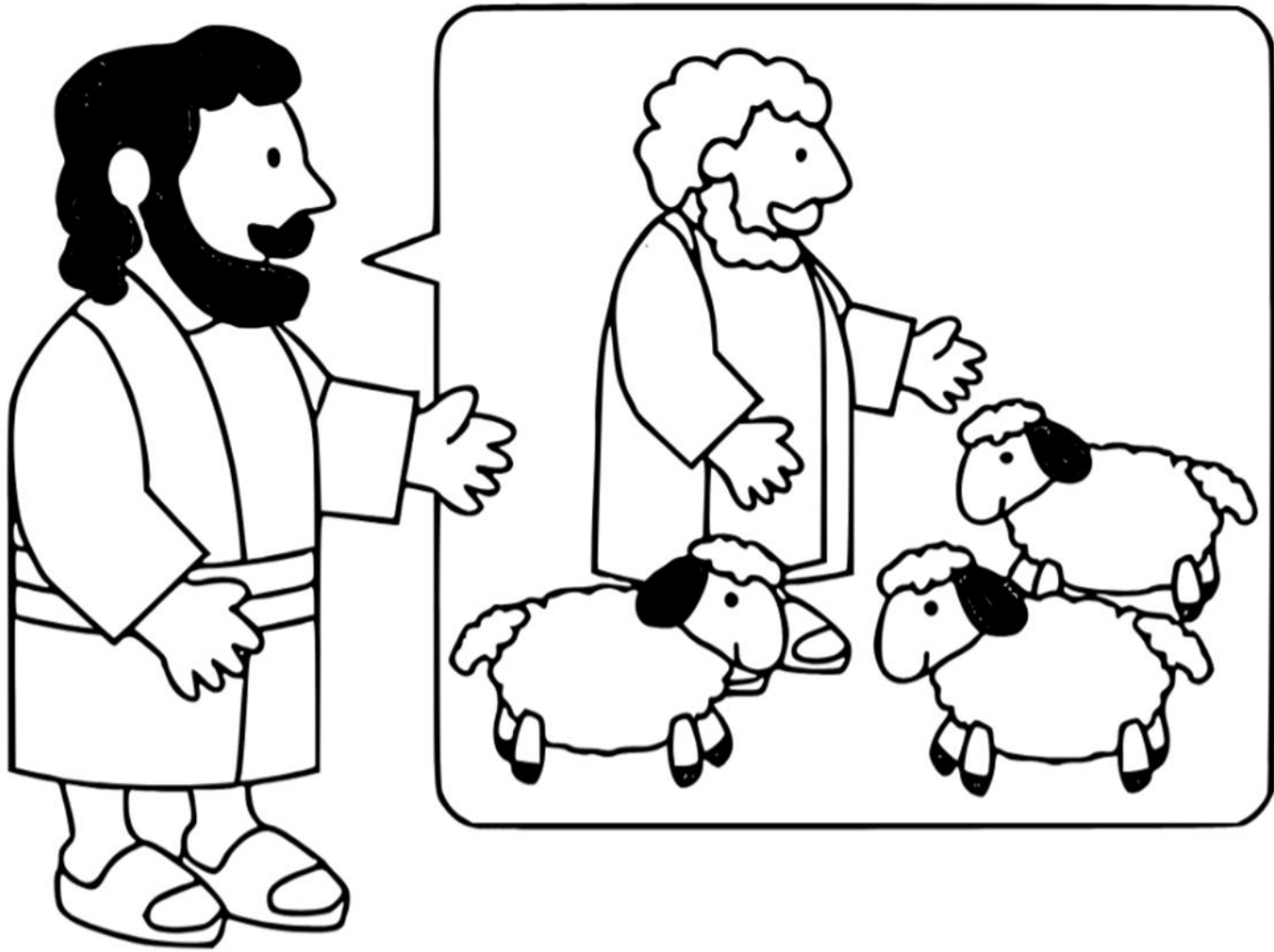

The sheep listen to the voice of the shepherd. He calls his sheep, using their names, and he leads them out.



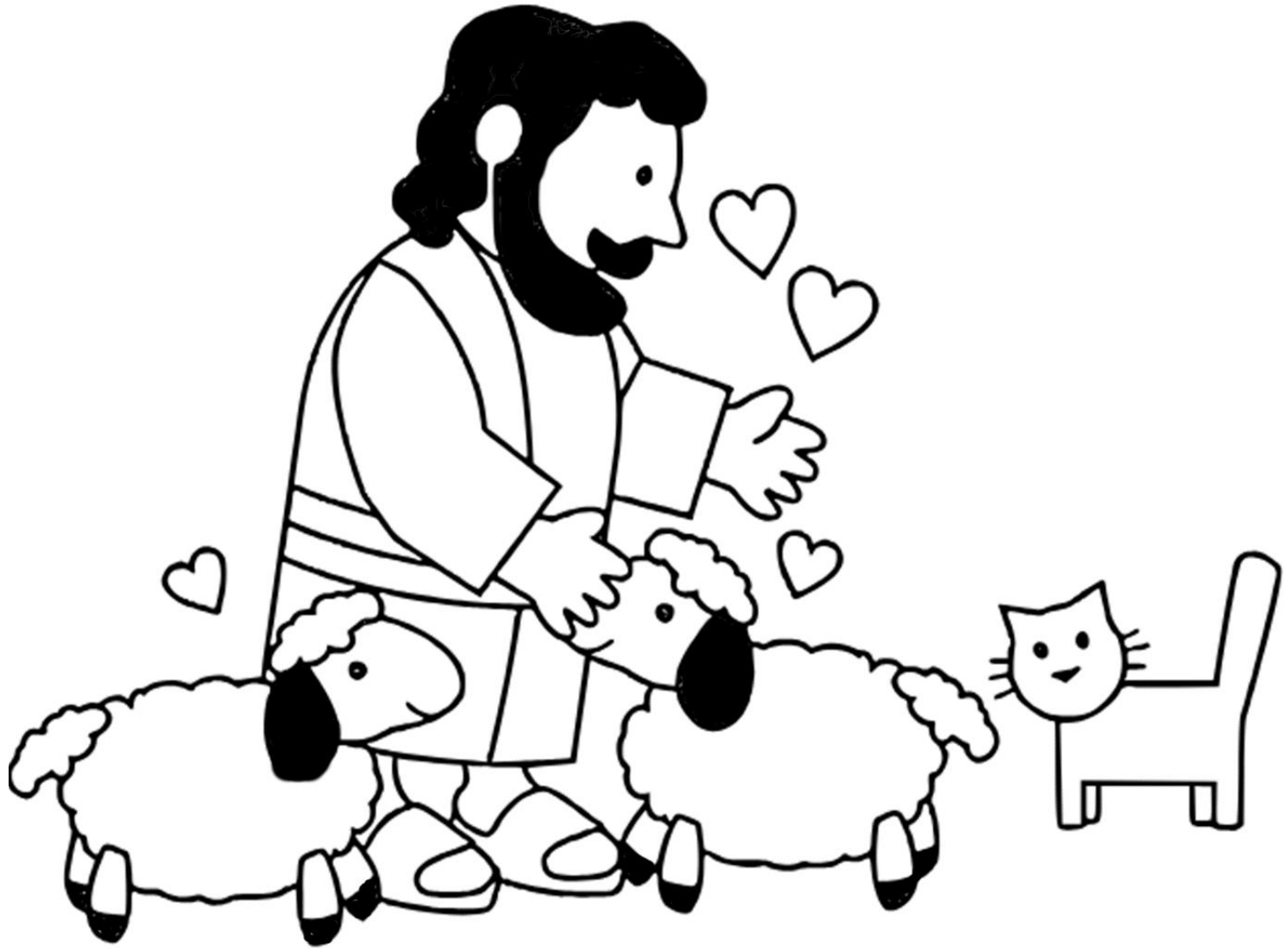

Then he goes ahead of them and leads them. The sheep follow him, because they know his voice.



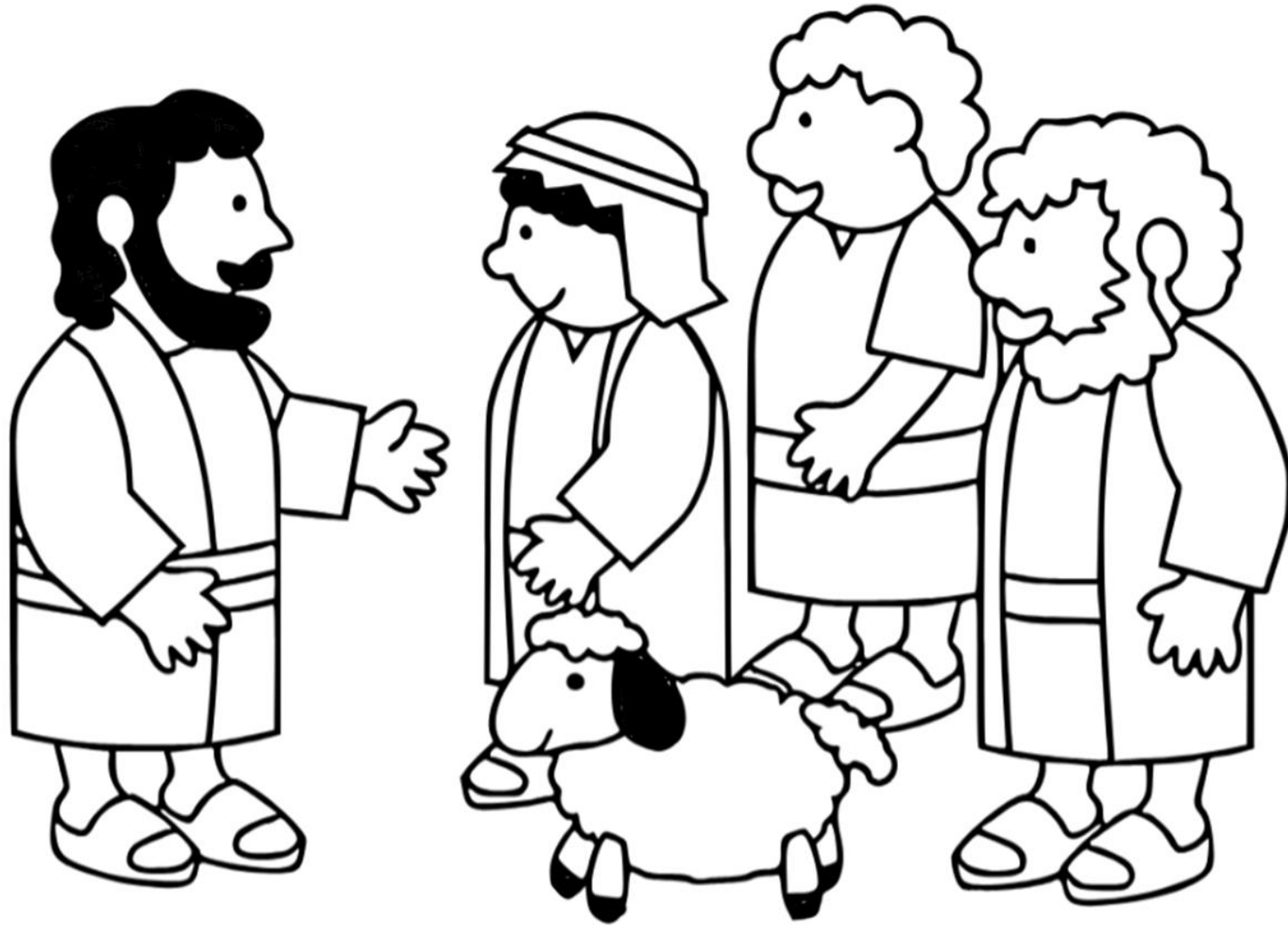
رَوَى لَهُمْ يَسُوعُ هَذَا الْمَثَلَ الرَّمَزِيَّ، لَكِنَّهُمْ لَمْ يَفْهَمُوا مَا قَالَهُ. فَأَضَافَ يَسُوعُ وَقَالَ: «أَنَا فَإِنِّي الرَّاعِي الصَّالِحُ.»

Those who heard Jesus use this illustration didn't understand what he meant, so he explained it to them: "I am the shepherd who cares for the sheep."
