strong.

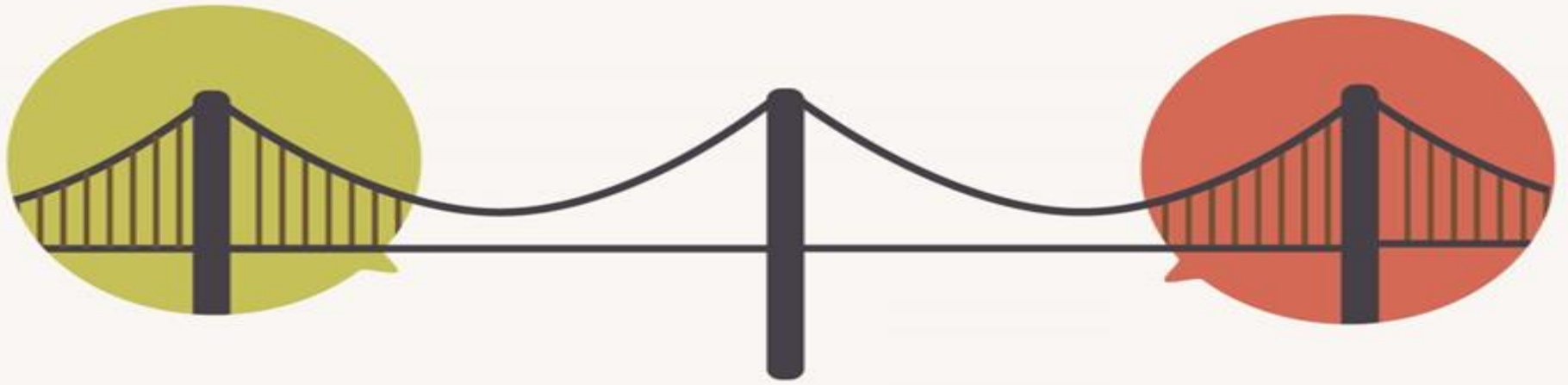
