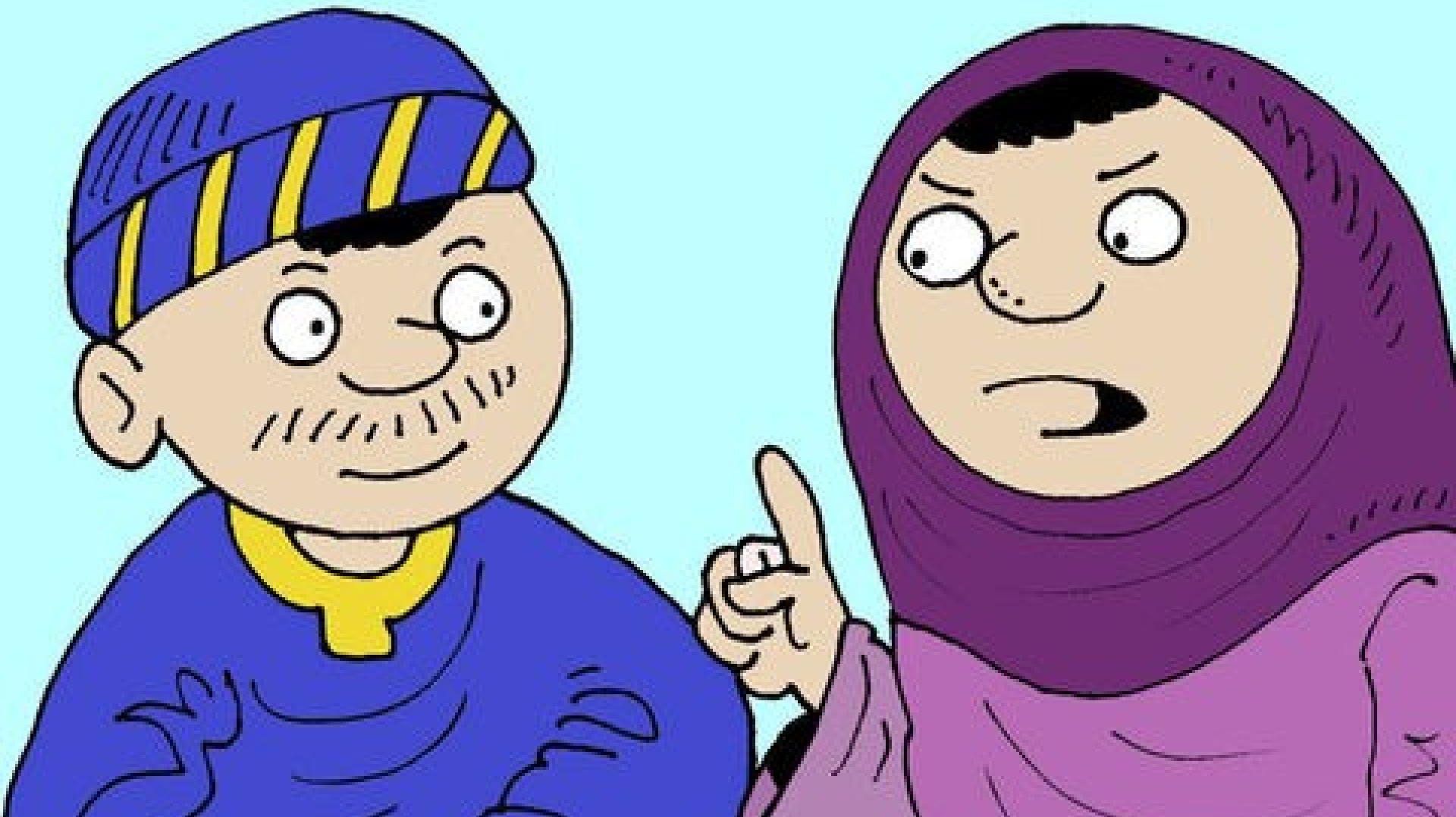
Jésus leur dit cette parabole pour leur montrer qu'ils devaient toujours prier, sans jamais se décourager:



“Once there was a judge in a town. He did not care about God. He also did not care what people thought about him.

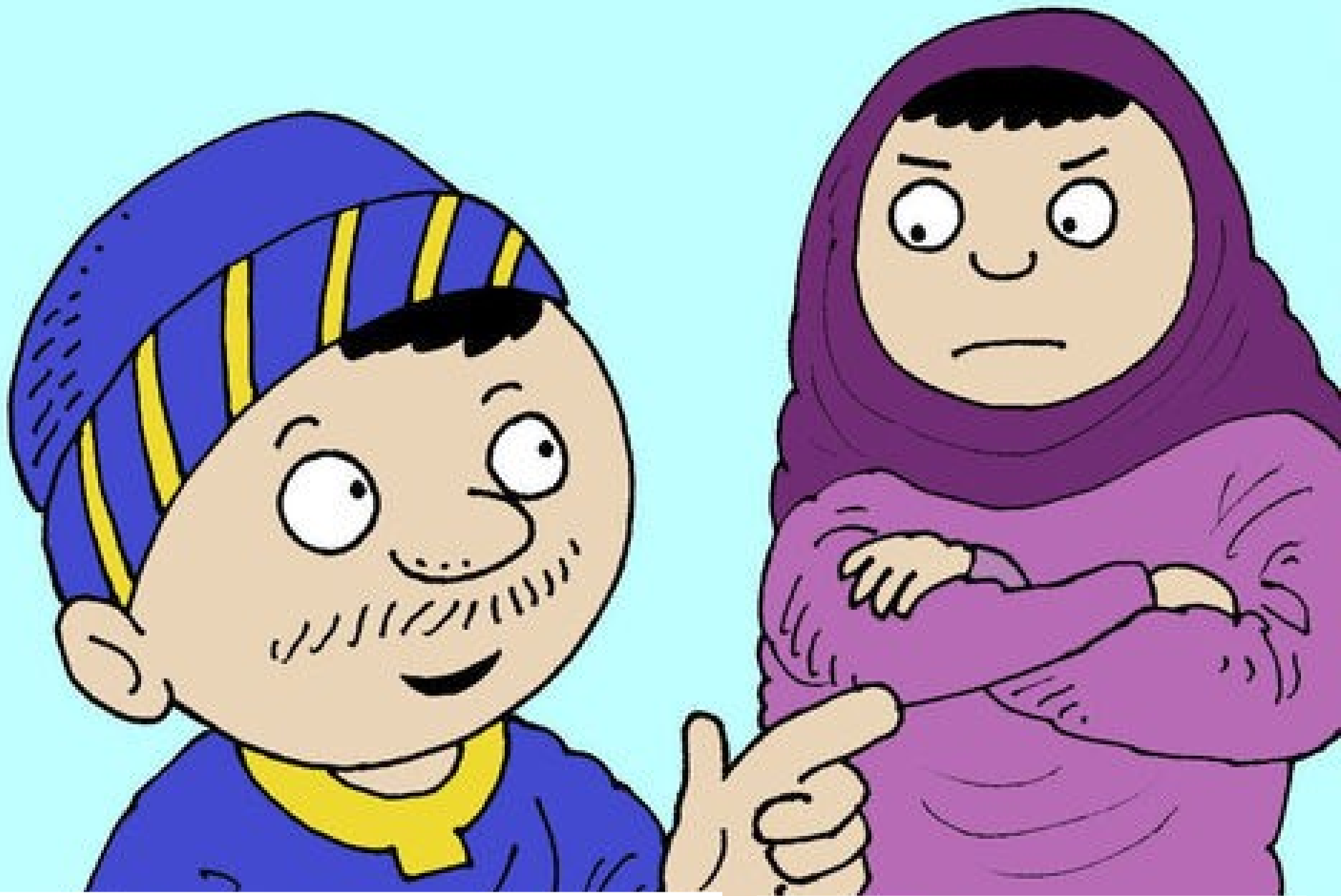
«Il y avait dans une ville un juge qui ne se souciait pas de Dieu et n'avait d'égards pour personne.

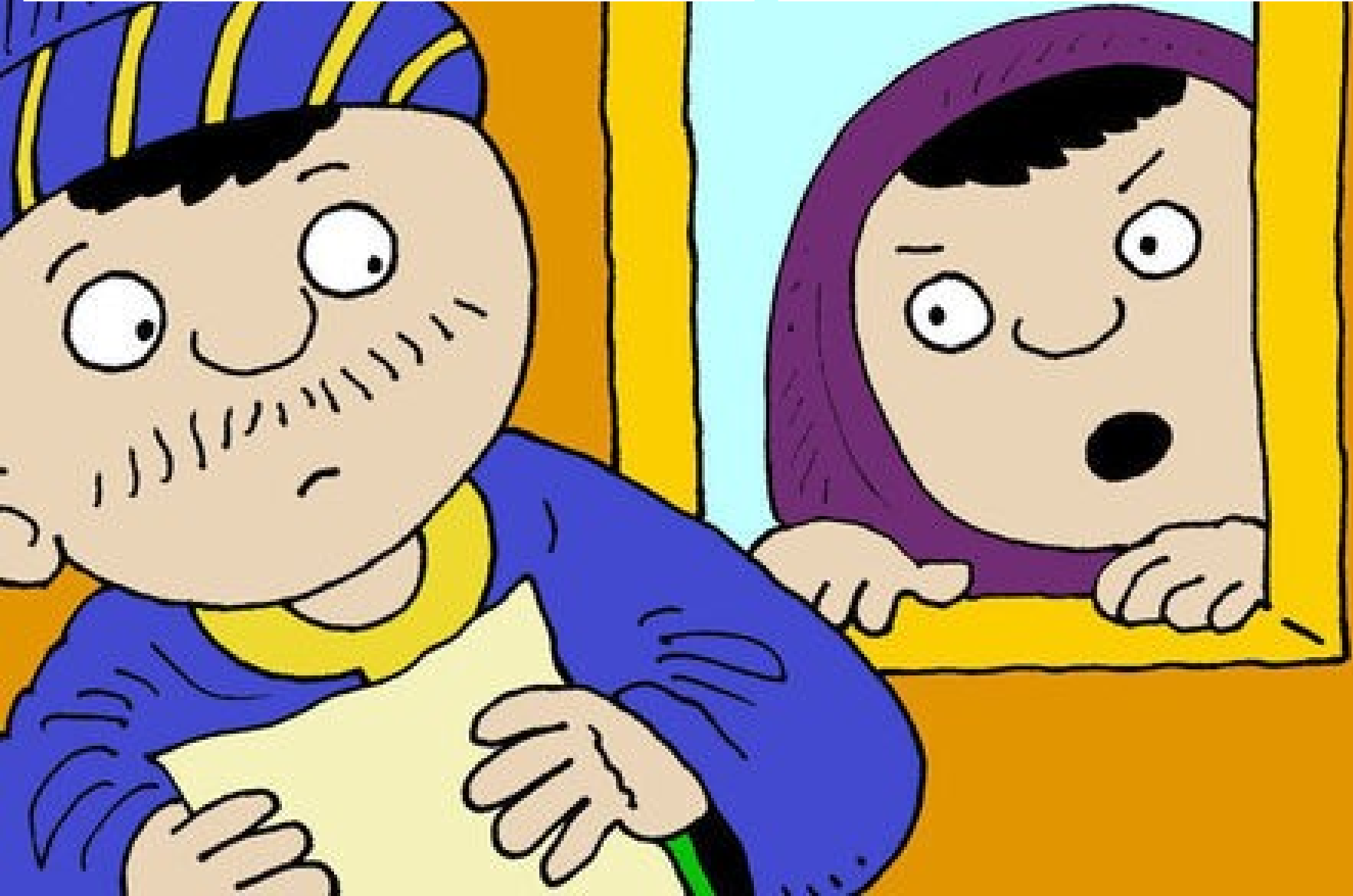


But the judge did not want to help the woman.
