


# The Story of the Persistent Widow

## *Parabola del giudice e della vedova*


*Diceva loro una parabola sulla necessità di pregare sempre, senza stancarsi mai:*

In quella città c'era anche una vedova, che andava da lui e gli diceva: «Fammi giustizia contro il mio avversario».




But the judge did not want to help the woman.
